

# COMPLETE CONCORDANCE and CYCLOPEDIA INDEX

Every word in the Bible is listed in this Index in alphabetical order, besides many other words related to Scripture but not actually found in the text itself. A number in parentheses following a word tells how many times it is used in the Bible. Aaron (322), for instance, means that the word Aaron occurs 322 times throughout the text of both Testaments. A letter following a verse reference, as in Lev. 16:2, **b**, indicates that the index entry refers to the note associated with the verse, rather than the verse itself.
